





Beginning as a classically trained pianist at age 6, his decades-long career has been that of a composer, producer. and publisher as well as a recording artist on 3 different record labels including Intentcity Records as the artist "Eterna" doing global chill-out EDM music. Since 2007, he has produced and arranged the music for the glamorous shows of Dita Von Teese - world renowned fashion icon and burlesque star. As a composer, Chuck's music has been heard daily for years on reality shows, talk shows, news programs, game shows, documentaries, entertainment news, and dramas. He was also a long-time TAXI member who is among the first wave of members to selflessly share his knowledge and experience with newer members.
